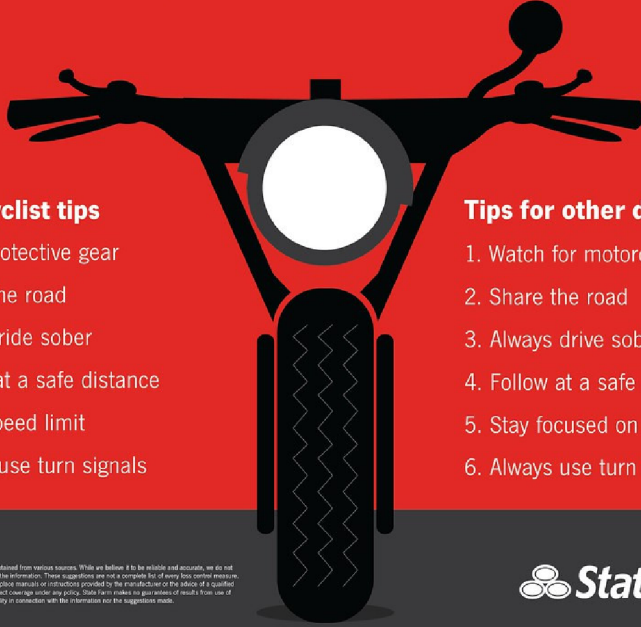

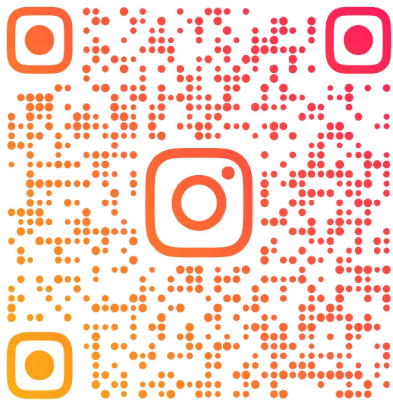
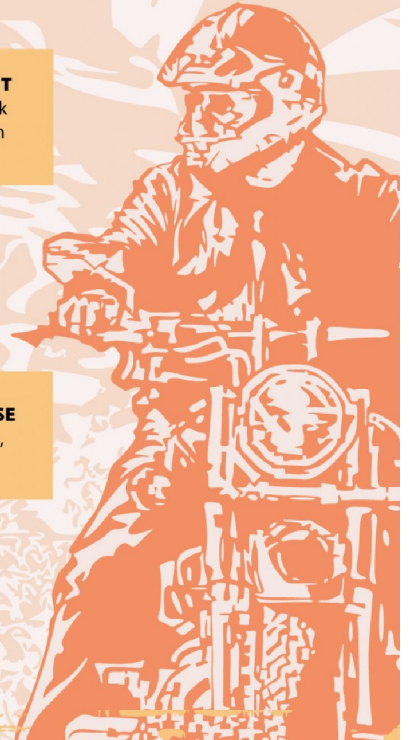
DON'T RIDE BEHIND LARGE TRUCKS
