Summer Fire Safety

BEFORE YOU LIGHT THE FIRE

Choose a Safe Spot:

Level, open area away from buildings, trees, dry grass, and branches.

Clear the Zone:

Remove flammable items within a 10-foot radius

Store Firewood Wisely:

30 feet away from the fire pit and structures

Check Weather & Restrictions:

Avoid windy days and follow local fire rules



WHILE THE FIRE IS BURNING

Keep Tools Ready:

Shovel, water bucket, and fire extinguisher

Use a Fire Screen:

Stop sparks from escaping

Supervise Constantly:

Never leave the fire

Teach Safety:

Remember Safety like "Stop, Drop, & Roll"



WHEN YOU'RE DONE

Put Out Completely:

Douse, stir, and douse again-fire until cold to the touch

Dispose of Ashes Safely:

Never bury hot ashes-they can reignite

Check your smoke detector—working alarms save lives!
