

BACK TO SCHOOL ROAD SAFETY REMINDERS

WATCH FOR SCHOOL ZONES

Slow down and obey posted school-zone speed limits. Expect sudden stops, crossing guards, and children darting out unexpectedly.

WATCH FOR PEDESTRIANS & BICYCLISTS

Children on bicycles may not always follow traffic rules. Give them extra space and reduce your speed when passing young cyclists.

WATCH FOR SCHOOL BUSES

Stop when red lights are flashing and the stop arm is extended—this is both the law and a life-saving measure. Allow extra space for buses to merge back into traffic.

ALWAYS STAY FOCUSED

Put away distractions like phones. Be especially cautious in residential areas and parking lots.

HAVE EXTRA PATIENCE

Morning and afternoon routes may take longer due to heavier traffic. Plan ahead and leave extra time so you're not tempted to rush.
