VISIBILITY IS KEY



HUNTERS:

- Wear required blaze orange or other high-visibility gear.
- Clearly mark blinds or stands when appropriate.



NON-HUNTERS:

- Wear bright colors when outdoors; avoid natural/neutral tones.
- Use high-visibility gear for pets.



BE AWARE OF YOUR SURROUNDINGS



- Hunters: Know your target and what's beyond it.
- Non-Hunters: Stay on marked paths and avoid wandering into unclear or posted areas.

Hunting season is safe when everyone stays visible, aware, and respectful. Small precautions from hunters and non-hunters alike help protect each other and ensure safe outdoor experiences for all.
