

Be Prepared for Severe Weather

Severe weather can develop quickly and create dangerous conditions at work, on the road, or at home. Taking a few minutes to prepare can help prevent injuries and keep you safe.

Before Severe Weather:

- Monitor weather alerts on your phone or radio
- Know where your safe shelter location is
- Secure loose outdoor items and equipment
- Plan ahead if storms are expected

If Severe Weather Occurs:

- Move indoors or to a safe shelter immediately
- Stay away from windows and open areas
- Avoid driving through heavy storms or flooded roads
- Wait until conditions improve before resuming work
