WORK ZONES REQUIRE EXTRA FOCUS

Narrow lanes, sudden stops, traffic pattern shifts, and uneven road surfaces create serious hazards—especially for large vehicles.

Large trucks are overrepresented in fatal work zone crashes.

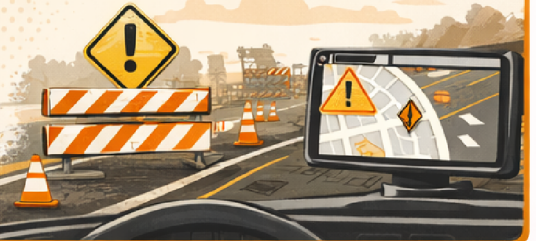
Stay alert. Conditions can change quickly.



DRIVE SMART IN WORK ZONES

- Research your route before you go and avoid work zones when possible.
- Pay attention to signs for speed changes and lane shifts.
- Slow down and watch for workers and changing conditions.

Avoid distractions at all times.



CONTROL YOUR SPACE

- Move into the open lane early when approaching closures.
- Be aware of blind spots and surrounding vehicles.
- Keep extra distance—rear-end crashes are common in work zones.

Space and positioning keep everyone safe.



WORK ZONE REALITY

- Work zones change quickly and leave little room for error.
- Reduced speeds, shifting lanes, and close traffic increase risk.

Rear-end crashes are one of the most common work zone incidents.
