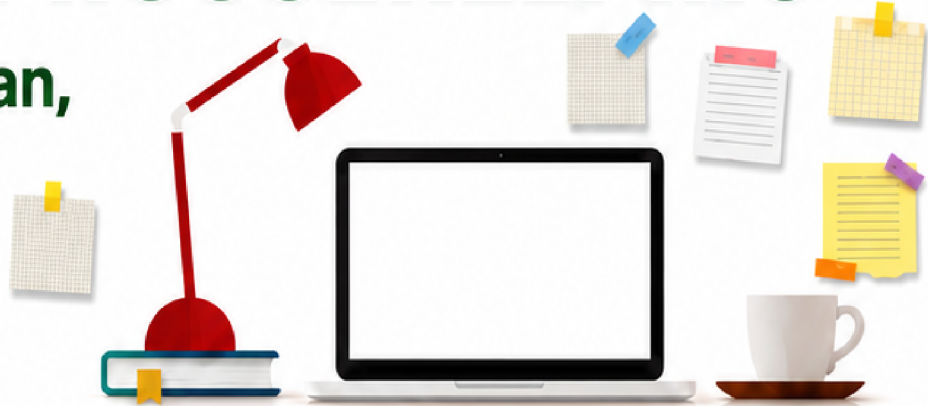


WORKPLACE HOUSEKEEPING

STEPS TO A SAFER WORKPLACE



ELIMINATE HAZARDS

that cause slips, trips and falls.



ELIMINATE FIRE

hazards and keep exits and aisles clear.



REPLACE BURNED

out bulbs, and keep light fixtures clean to ensure adequate light.



INSPECT ELECTRICAL

cords and make sure cords are not overloading outlets.



TAKE STEPS

to prevent falling objects and always store heavy objects close to the floor.



AVOID TRACKING

materials to prevent the spread of hazardous materials to other work areas.



STORE MATERIALS

properly and dispose of materials that are no longer needed.



CLEAR CLUTTER

from work spaces and aisles.
